Music In Our Schools to be held Thursday, April 10th

The Martin County School District will sponsor the 34th annual *Music In Our Schools* program on **Thursday, April 10th, at 7:00 P.M.** The event will be held in **Martin County High School's gymnasium (The Don Wallen Sports Complex)**. Nearly 700 public school students from elementary school, middle school, and high school will demonstrate their talents during the concert.

Participants include music teachers and their students from Jensen Beach High School, Martin County High School, South Fork High School, Dr. David L. Anderson Middle, Hidden Oaks Middle, Indiantown Middle, Murray Middle, and Stuart Middle. A combined chorus of almost 400 voices will represent Bessey Creek Elementary, Crystal Lake Elementary, Felix A. Williams Elementary, Hobe Sound Elementary, Jensen Beach Elementary, Palm City Elementary, J.D. Parker School of Science, Math and Technology, Pinewood Elementary, Port Salerno Elementary, SeaWind Elementary, and Warfield Elementary. The county-wide chorus, "Friends," will also perform.

The theme for this year's *Music in Our Schools* is "**Music Touches Lives**". The festival's finale is "God Bless America", words and music by Irving Berlin, and arranged by Keith Christopher.

The public and the media are cordially invited to attend and enjoy this gala event of musical entertainment. The program will provide a special opportunity for citizens to understand, support, and become aware of the on-going processes of music education in our schools.
