**Information for parents about Free Tutoring for eligible students at Port Salerno
Elementary, Indiantown Middle, and
J.D. Parker School of Science, Math, and Technology**

Parents whose children attend *J.D. Parker School of Science, Math, and Technology, Port Salerno Elementary, and Indiantown Middle School* are encouraged to learn more about Supplemental Educational Services (SES) by attending free tutoring fairs at the schools next week (dates/times are listed below). During the tutoring fairs, private tutoring vendors will be available to talk to parents about their services.

To qualify for SES, students must attend a school that receives federal money and did not meet all of the criteria for making AYP three years in a row under the *No Child Left Behind Act*. Students also must be eligible to receive a free or reduced-price lunch. Tutoring services are prioritized based on educational need. All tutoring will be done before or after school. Fees will be paid by the School District. The School District has contacted the parents of qualifying students.
