Martin County School District SAT Scores Higher than the State and National Averages

August 25, 2009– Today, the College Board released SAT Scores for 2009 seniors in the Martin County School District. The results show students in Martin County (district-wide) scored above state and national averages in each area tested, including Critical Reading, Math, and Writing.

In addition, mean scores for each of the individual high schools show students scored above the state and national averages in Critical Reading and Math. Individual school results for Writing show students scored above the state average at each high school, and also above the national average at Martin County High School and Jensen Beach High School.
